

## 2009 Football Gazette All-Super Region Four Team

PITTSBURG, Kan. — *Don Hansen's Football Gazette* has released its 2009 NCAA Division II All-Super Region Four squad today (Jan. 6).

This marks the seventh year *Football Gazette* has selected NCAA Division II All-Region teams. The national publication, an authority on small college football, has selected NCAA Division II All-America teams since 1988.

The first-team and second-team All-Region selections advance to a national ballot from which the 2009 NCAA Division II *Football Gazette* All-America team will be named in later this month.

National Champion Northwest Missouri State University of the MIAA led the way with 10 honorees, including four first-team selections. Lone Star Conference member Abilene Christian University also had seven all-region recipients – three first-team honorees. The University of Central Washington, from the Great Northwest Athletic Conference, as well as LSC member Midwestern State University and MIAA member Washburn University received six selections apiece on the All-Region teams.

A total of 93 players earned some form of *Football Gazette* All-Super Region Four honors. Players from 27 of the 34 football-playing schools in Super Region Four earned All-Region accolades.
